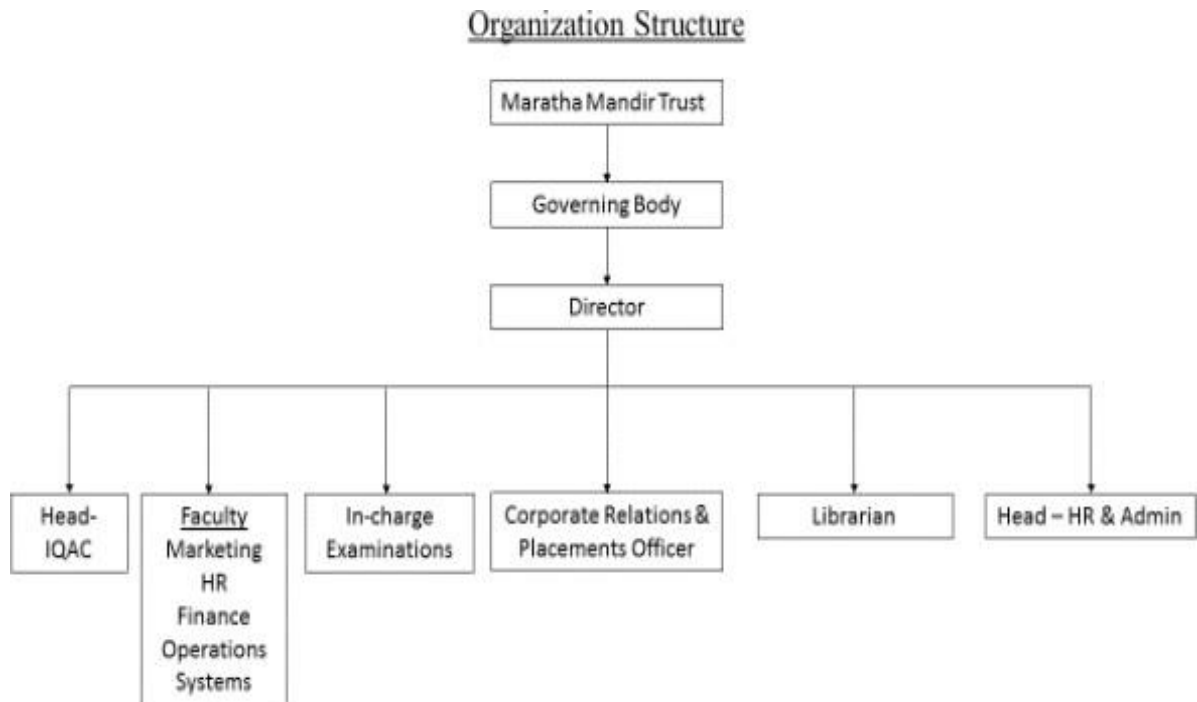

- e. **Nature and extent of Involvement of faculty and students in academic affairs/improvements** - Our faculty is dedicated to their profession and is committed to the development of students. Faculties submit the session plan, which is consistent with guidelines issued by University of Mumbai, at the beginning of the semester. Each faculty is allotted an equal number of students for one on one mentoring and counseling session throughout all semesters. Institute is student centric and students are involved in almost all the activities. Institute constitutes different committees which also comprises of students with a faculty

coordinator and a faculty member. To name a few: Cultural, Gymkhana, Anti-ragging, Women Development Cell, and Entrepreneurship cell, Student Council etc. are constituted with student members.

Various activities are organized by students under respective committees which creates a sense of participative management, team building and leadership among the students. Magma - cultural (annual event) and other cultural events are organized by Cultural committee, sports activities are organized by Gymkhana committee, alumni meet is organized by Alumni forum, Guest lectures are organized by student council. To name a few sessions: GST, LinkedIn profile built up, Compassionate Listening etc. Field visits are also organized and all major events like Industrial Visit includes participation of students in organizing the same. Students are part of most of the committees as facilitators. Students take a lead in celebrating the commemorative days at the Institute. The Social Responsibility committee works towards organizing activities to sensitize students towards problems related to deprived sections of society. Social projects are undertaken by the students wherein they visit the underprivileged and create awareness of rising social issues.
