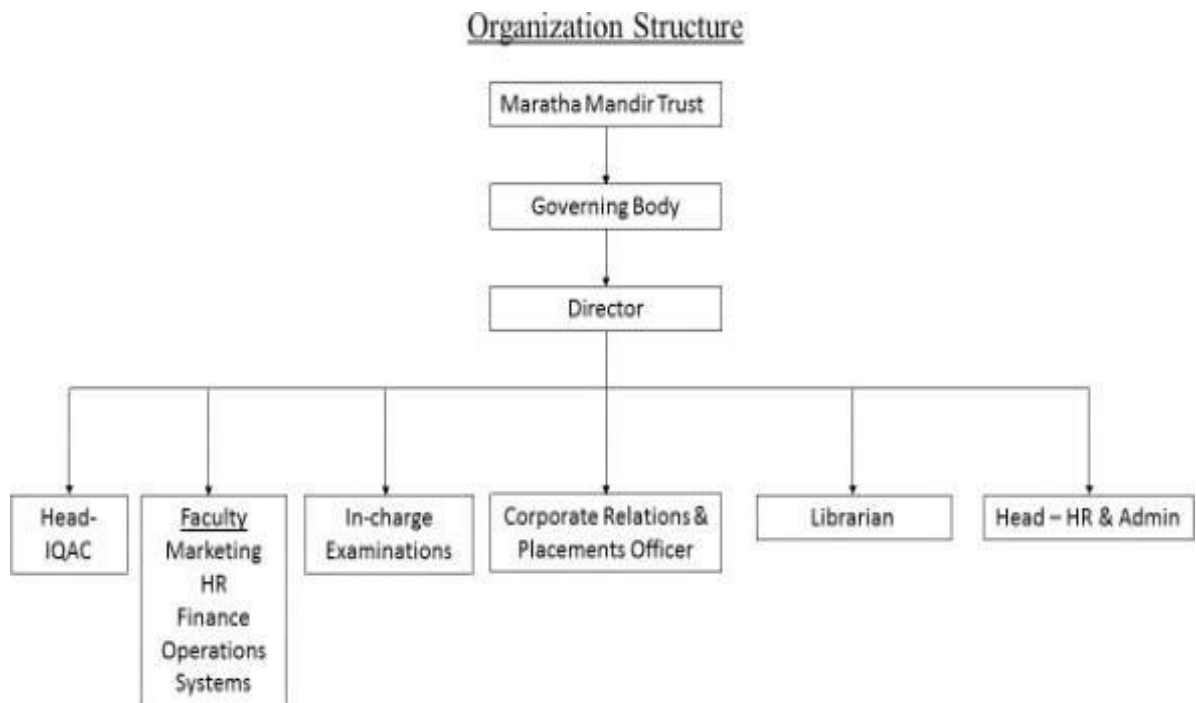

- e. **Nature and extent of Involvement of faculty and students in academic affairs/improvements** - Our faculty is dedicated to their profession and is

committed to the development of students. Faculties submit the session plan, which is consistent with guidelines issued by University of Mumbai, at the beginning of the semester. Each faculty is allotted an equal number of students for one on one mentoring and counseling session throughout all semesters. Institute is student centric and students are involved in almost all the activities. Institute constitutes different committees which also comprises of students with a faculty coordinator and a faculty member.
